Mary's son is about to die a cruel, senseless death on a Roman cross. Still, in the midst of the pain and suffering, Jesus' concern was for His mother. In that moment Jesus redefines the word "family."

Do you have any friends who are so much like family you could crash their Christmas Day celebrations?
