Jeremiah 22:1-9

"Plus, maybe they'll have some more food."*

In Psalm 146, we see a sneak peek of God's character and job description: faithful forever, defending the oppressed, feeding the hungry, setting prisoners free, giving sight to the blind, lifting up the lowly, caring for the foreigner and defenseless.
