Matt had a fast-growing vine on his fence. He tried repeatedly to remove it so passersby could see his decorations. He had no success until he could find the source vine that was feeding the other branches.

John 15 tells us to remain in God's love like the branch does to the vine. In other words, we should take our life and strength from Christ. God has loved us with agape love which Jesus showed us is cross-type love.
