## 1 Thessalonians 1:1-10

Paul's ministry in Thessalonica had been remarkably fruitful. He, Timothy, and Silas had gone there after a very tumultuous experience in Philippi. When you read the letter you sense that in a short period of time a deep and abiding affection had formed between Paul and the new believers.

In his commendation of the Thessalonians, Paul said that they had become imitators of Paul and his companions, and of the Lord. Self-giving service is contagious.
