Psalm 91:1-8

Have you ever noticed that painful experiences and unexpected sorrows enter our lives without an appointment? Enemies only bring havoc and destruction. As we ponder the snapshots of our lives, some memories could be painful. But please know that the Lord offers rest in our weariness. Not every snapshot has to become a permanent portrait because we know God is mightier than all our experiences.

Scriptures encourage us to express our anguish to God, as in Psalm 90. There is a shift, however, that takes place in Psalm 91, moving from lament to trust. Trust is expressed as an act of genuine worship.

This Psalm invites us to place our trust in God while we wait in hope with confidence. Psalm 91 encourages belief in the rescue, security, and protection of God.
