Jeremiah 31:31-34

The prophet Jeremiah saw that the hearts of the people around him were full of sin. Great judgment was surely coming. Was there no hope? Although they made sacrifices and observed the worship rituals, their hearts were not right with God. They stole from the poor, shed innocent blood, lied freely, and worshipped idols. Their "devotion" to God was shallow and superficial.
