## **Description**

Proverbs 22:4-15

The duality presented in Proverbs 22 is important to note. Humility is juxtaposed against the fear of the Lord because the two are inextricably linked. Humility is the way we see ourselves. Fear of the Lord is the way we see God. If we exalt ourselves too highly, we won't be able to get out of our own way in order to truly honor and worship the Lord.
