Description

Acts 1:1-11

Whether they whispered it to each other, or silently asked it in their minds, surely they thought the same thing: "What is He talking about? He's alive and back! When are we going to get moving with this 'Kingdom of God' thing?" They did finally give voice to their perplexity: "Jesus, are you going to restore Israel to its rightful place now?"
