James outlines here a set of contrasts. The writer contrasts salty water with freshwater. He proposes that the nature of plants determines their fruit. He sets down the foundation of his pinnacle argument: What is in a person's heart determines their course and will be seen by the world. Manipulation and a self-serving disposition will be revealed in the end, just as fruit reveals the type of plant that is growing.
