

Which Foundation?

Description

Matthew 7:24-29

Jesusâ?? parable contrasts two builders and two foundations: wise and foolish, rock and sand. Sand, with its fine grains, is easily shifted by flowing water. Making it an unsure foundation. Solid rock (*petra*: â??ledge,â?• or â??bedrockâ??) makes a sure foundation. The same word appears later when Jesus tells Simon, â??And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome itâ?• (16:18). That rock was Peterâ??s proclamation of faith in Jesus as â??the Messiah, the Son of the living Godâ?• (16:16).

This parable comes at the end of the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). It may seem a strange way to end a sermon. Yet, like all good sermons, it leads us to a â??crisisâ?• (<u>krisis</u>, a â??separation,â?• â??judgement,â?• or â??decisionâ?•). The hearer is encouraged to ask, â??What have I built my life upon?â?• The shifting sand of unstable human opinion or achievement, or the solid rock of faith in Christ Jesus and His unshakable kingdom?
