

## When Bigger Isnâ??t Better

## **Description**

Matthew 7:13-20

We live in a world in which bigger is usually considered better. For instance, to get the best deal you might go to a value club where, when buying paper towels, you get 15 <u>mega</u> rolls. Or consider your car: popularity of SUVs and trucks continues to rise. Who couldnâ??t appreciate a wider closet? Countries brag and rely on the biggest military, GNP, or test scores. Itâ??s easy to think that bigger is better, because often it is.

Sometimes bigger is <u>not</u> better . . . like when Jesus said that â?? <u>small</u> is the gate and <u>narrow</u> the road that leads to lifeâ?• (v. 14, emphasis added). Small and narrow? That doesnâ??t sound too appealing, does it? But Jesus isnâ??t too concerned with our comfort. He is concerned with <u>life</u>. We have the very life and words of Jesus to show us life; we have <u>life</u> himself to show us life (see John 14:6).

Jesus said that only a few would find the gate and road. If youa??ve found it, who else will you lead to it?
