Ezekiel 36:24-32

Like a small child that's been jumping in mud puddles or our dog, Daisy, who likes to run through the rancid pond in our backyard, someone else has to do the dirty work of cleaning up. God knows we can't clean ourselves from the messes we make and the sin in our lives. Instead of condemning us, He cleanses us and says, "I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh (v. 26)".
