Luke 1:57-66

Zechariah's priestly order was on duty in the temple. There were 24 orders that rotated, offering sacrifices, and burning incense in the holy places. There were so many priests that this was likely Zachariah's only opportunity to serve. And what should happen? An angel appeared, giving him Abraham-sized baby news, and his disbelief ends in a quiet nine months for Elizabeth! He was mute, waiting for the baby's birth. The baby comes, Zechariah names him John, and miraculously his tongue is freed!
