John 17:20-26

The story is told of a little boy who caught a bird and thought he'd have some fun with a wise old man who was blind. The boy held the bird in his hands and asked the old man, "Mister, if you are so wise, tell me, is the bird in my hands dead or alive?" The wise old man thought to himself, "If I say the bird is alive, the boy will squeeze the bird to death. If I say the bird is dead, the boy will turn the bird loose."
