Psalm 27:1-6

In Psalm 27, David highlights Godâ??s presence and protection. He speaks of Godâ??s â??house,â?• â??temple,â?• â??dwelling,â?• and â??sacred tent,â?• all symbolizing Godâ??s â??strongholdâ?• in which he finds that continual protection (vv. 1, 4, 5). He also speaks of â??the wicked,â?• â??enemies,â?• â??foes,â?• even â??an armyâ?• (vv. 2, 3).

With this turmoil and danger all around, David should be descending into spiritual and emotional darkness, needing sessions with his counselors. He doesnâ??t need them, however, â??The LORD is my light and my salvationâ??whom shall I fear?â?• (v. 1)<u>The LORD</u> lights up <u>all</u> of Davidâ??s journey! Godâ??s salvation envelops all of Davidâ??s life.

David recalls a ?? the beauty [presence] of the LORDa? (v. 4), which so inspired him when he last visited Goda?? s sanctuary. This brings on joyous shouting, singing, and music-making, as though he were at the a ?? sacred tenta? itself (v. 6).

May you and I know that Godâ??s beautiful presence that so blesses us in Sunday worship does not remain only in the sanctuary. It continues to envelop us throughout every dayâ??s journey.
