2 Corinthians 1:1-11

Paul begins his second letter to the Corinthians with a word of hope and good news. Our God is the God of comfort and compassion! The Lord draws near to those who are suffering and broken; He provides comfort in the midst of dark circumstances.

The good news for us today is that our God is the same as Paul described so long ago. Our God is still the God of comfort for the hurting.
