Isaiah 43:1-7

It was the summer of the year 2000. Mark was in seminary in Kansas City and had started dating a wonderful lady named Stefanie. Late that summer, he was asked to preach at a youth camp in central California. As he boarded the plane to fly out west, he opened his travel case and found a letter from Stefanie. It was the first true love letter he had received in years and years.
