Street preacher Woman Wisdom doesnâ??t stop preaching. She calls out an urgent warning to those passing by on the cityâ??s streetsâ??the hawkers, gawkers, deliverersâ??you â??simpleâ?• and you â??foolsâ?• (v. 32).

You rejected â??knowledge.â?• You mocked â??my rebuke.â?• You were complacent. You refused â??my advice.â?• You turned away from the â??fear of the LORDâ?• (v. 29). Your choices â??will destroyâ?• you! Yes, they â??will killâ?• you! (v. 32).

When you least expect it, without warning, with the suddenness of a tornado, calamity and disaster will crash in upon you. You will call out to me: Wisdom! But itâ?? Il be too late. â?? I will not answerâ?• (1:28).

Wisdomâ??s urgent advice to you readers: â??Choose to fear the LORDâ?• (v. 29). Then you â??will live in safety and be at ease, without fear of harmâ?• (v. 33).
