Daniel 2:14-23

Daniel spoke with wisdom and tact, sought clarity, and responded calmly to the king's command to kill the wise counselors for their lack of insight into his dream. Daniel set the example for all of us in times of uncertainty. He sought wisdom from God rather than planning how to divert the disaster (of which he would have been included). He went to God and asked for wisdom and insight. When God answered his prayer, Daniel's immediate response was that of praise and thanksgiving.
