

Follow Jesusâ?? Instructions

Description

Matthew 28:18-20.

Yesterdayâ??s devotional concluded with Jesus commissioning His followers to be His â??witnesses . . . to the ends of the earthâ?• (Acts 1:8). In todayâ??s scripture, Jesus expands this commission. He does so as one to whom â??all authority in heaven and on earth has been givenâ?• (Matthew 28:18).

â??Authorityâ?• speaks of kingship. So, Jesus, King of all creation, sends His followers out to â??make disciples of all nationsâ?• (v. 19). Making disciples has two components: â??baptizing themâ?• and â??teaching themâ?• (vv. 19, 20).

New believers who have placed their faith in Jesus for salvation and have witnessed to their faith are to be baptized in the name of the Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (v. 19). This act of baptism is a public witness to the church that these believers are now in covenant relationship with God and Godâ??s people.

To become a true disciple of Jesus, the new believer must now be taught Jesusâ??s commandments. Whether a new or longtime disciple, learning to live like Christ is a lifetime journey. However, Jesus assures both disciple and teacher, â??â??l am with you always, to the very end of the age'â?• (v. 20).
