

The Merciful Kingdom

Description

Matthew 5:7-12.

May I share my pastorâ??s heart with you for a moment? Iâ??m <u>tired</u> of watching people of faith turn the kingdom of God into a power trip. Itâ??s easy to do. We focus on things like â??true justiceâ?• and â??lawbreakersâ?• getting what they deserve. We focus on winning arguments in an effort to feel better about our faith and ourselves. We label peopleâ??Godâ??s peopleâ??as spiritual enemies when they do not agree with us politically. We do harm to others in the name of â??defending the faith.â?• Iâ??m tired of it.

Jesus says, â??Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercyâ?• (v. 7). Pause with me a moment and consider those words. The blessings of the kingdom are for the merciful. Do you want the blessings of God? You must show mercy. Thereâ??s no way around it. Thereâ??s no pretending those words arenâ??t there.

The way of Jesus is the way of the merciful, the peacemakers, the pure in heart. May these words of Jesus pull us off our power trips and show us a more excellent way: the way of wholehearted love of God and neighbor. This way is never a power trip.
