Descripción

James 1:12-18.

As a young pastor in Nebraska, I was once offered a church in Florida—in the dead of winter! Driving 90 miles on ice to Omaha made me late for my flight. I assumed the Lord was not in it.

At the gate I found the flight was delayed, so I thought, “The Lord is in it!” As the plane backed away, a woman reached to pull herself up in her seat, pulling a lever that released an escape chute, cancelling the flight. I thought, “The Lord is not in it!” The counter agent checked for another flight, and one miraculously popped up with one seat remaining. I surmised, “The Lord is in it!”

Reading James 1 on my return flight, I came across verse 14, how we’re tempted by our own desires. I thought, “It’s okay to want to pastor a stronger church and reach more people.” Then verse 15 addresses desires becoming sin and eventually death. Verse 16: “Do not be deceived!” That’s when I decided, “The Lord was not in it,” and we remained in Nebraska.

God continued to bless our ministry there in the Midwest. He promises to bless as long as we persevere.
