1 Peter 5:6-11.

Life is full of journeys. Each journey is packed with highs and lows, mountaintops and valleys. We encounter victory; we encounter failure. We do our best—sometimes, we do our least—and still try to survive and even thrive through each mile.

At the end of a good journey, God is there. Celebrating, loving, excited with us and for us. At the end of a painful journey, God is also there. Mourning, hurting, grieving with us and for us.

The next step after a long journey—good or bad—is my favorite one. Peter reminds us that God HIMSELF will restore us. God himself . . .
